

Breeder and Purchaser Agreement

Health Agreement:

This puppy you are purchasing is in good health at the time of sale. The buyer will have 72-hours in which to have the puppy examined by their own veterinarian. Please submit clinical review by said vet to the breeder at 72-hour appointment. If the buyer fails to take the puppy to the vet or give the breeder a copy of the vet report/clearance letter this will be voiding your puppies 2-year warranty.

If the puppy is found to be ill by a licensed veterinarian and is to be returned due to illness, a letter from the veterinarian is required to be given to the breeder with said findings. This includes death or illness from any health condition deemed to be present prior to the leaving the seller's premises. Buyer shall assume any expenses associated with returning the puppy to the seller. The seller will, at the seller's discretion, refund the purchase price minus the \$350.00 deposit, return the dog to the buyer in healthy condition, OR exchange the dog for another dog of equal value. At no time and under no circumstances will the Breeder be responsible for any veterinary

Puppy Warranty:

This animal is warranted against FATAL GENETIC Defects or severe life altering diseases for 2 year from the date of purchase. Should this puppy be determined to be suffering from a fatal defect deemed to be hereditary (within the 2 year from the date of purchase), breeder will replace the puppy with one of the same values when one is available after notification or pay up to half of the purchase price of the puppy to the appropriate vet. Written verification must be furnished to the Breeder by TWO independent veterinarians specializing in the condition. Both Veterinarians must be approved by the Breeder. If condition is related to hips, elbows, eyes, patella or heart the verifications must come from an OFA or PennHip certified clinician. The breeder will not be responsible for any veterinary costs at anytime.

We cannot guarantee that your puppy will never develop any health problems, just as a pediatrician cannot guarantee that a child will never develop any health problems in the future. Some things are just not able to be predicted. Our parents are free of diseases, disorders, and health problems; otherwise we would not breed them. Both parents were tested on their hips elbows and eyes tested and received a clear screening for any hereditary concerns. Full DNA panels were completed for mom and dad; both were clear as well. That means our puppies are less likely to develop problems. If anything does occur, you are required to inform us so we can evaluate the parents and the other puppies from that litter to determine the cause of the ailment and to eliminate the issue from our breeding program.

The Breeder states that the puppy has received vaccines in accordance with their family veterinarian as of the date of the adoption. The attached schedule of vaccinations and treatments is required to be maintained by the purchaser to be in compliance with the 2 year health guarantee. Initial:
Socializing and Training: While the puppy is in my care for the 8 weeks, we are working on socializing the puppy, crate training, potty training and neural stimulation. This is in the best interest of the puppy and buyer. Each puppy's progress is different, and the breeder cannot guarantee the puppies progress to be equal as other, but the breeder has done the best overall lifestyle for the puppy while in my care for 8 weeks. However, the new owner continues to conduct the puppy's routine and training progress can be guided by the Breeders recommendations. Initial:

The Buyer Agreements:
Lifestyle Agreement: That this puppy will be given adequate and proper shelter and housed securely indoors. This dog shall not be neglected, allowed to roam free alone, or be mistreated in any manner. The puppy shall receive proper veterinary care throughout its life, receiving annual inoculations and placed on a heart worm preventative. The puppy shall receive proper nutrition and care shall be taken to maintain its proper weight. Buyer agrees to give the dog proper training and socialization. Buyer agrees to never sell or surrender this dog into a dog fighting institution, testing center or
shelter. Initial:
Vaccination Agreement: The Buyer agrees to finish all puppy vaccines before taking their puppy out in public, letting their puppy on public sidewalks and grasses, or letting their puppy be touched by people outside of the family. This reduces the chance of your puppy picking up a communicable disease such
